



TEST KNIT: SIMPLY TABOO SOCKS

I am seeking up to 5 preview knitters for a sock pattern. Please be sure to read through this entire call, paying special attention to the timeline and requirements, before volunteering.

PATTERN DESCRIPTION: The Simply Taboo socks are a follow up to the [Witchcraft hat](#) pattern published in 2019, using 2 colors of The Fiber Seed Sprout Sock, including her new colorway Andromeda. A similar criss-cross slipped stitch pattern decorates these socks, with contrast color toes, heels and cuffs.

SKILLS: Knitters should be familiar with

- toe-up sock construction
- reading charts

YARN: 2 skeins of fingering weight yarn in contrasting or coordinating colors.

SIZES: Finished foot circumference: 7 ½ (8, 8 ½, 9, 9 ½, 10)"/ 19 (20.5, 21.5, 23, 24, 25.5) cm

GAUGE: 32 sts and 40 rnds = 4"/10 cm in charted pattern, blocked.

SUGGESTED NEEDLES:

US 1.5 DPNs or long circular needle for magic loop

TIMELINE:

Open call posted: Tuesday, April 14

Draft pattern sent to testers: 8pm EDT Wednesday, April 15

Deadline: **Wednesday, May 13**

PREVIEW KNIT REQUIREMENTS (preview knitters use their own yarn for the project):

- Make a good faith effort to complete as much of the project as possible by May 10.
- Modifications are ok, but please note any mods on your Rav project page! You'll be asked to confirm your gauge, yardage and final dimensions in the post-test questionnaire.
- Please report any errors or unclear portions of the pattern in the Slack thread or to me via email.
- Create a Ravelry project page, with a photo, linked to the pattern page, on or before May 10.
- Complete the post-test survey *whenever you finish your project*.

COMPENSATION: Preview knitters who fulfill the requirements as specified are compensated with a free, final copy of the pattern, as well as any other single pattern from my Ravelry shop. I may also ask to feature your photos on the pattern page, or to showcase them on my blog or Instagram.
